The Miracle of the Loaves and Fishes

Unforgettable melodies and poignant lyrics abound in this inspiring musical based on the account of Jesus feeding the five thousand. Found in all four New Testament gospels, the story reveals how one young boy with five loaves of bread and two fish – and an apparent willingness to share – leads to an event so startling that members of the crowd wanted to proclaim Jesus as King. Later, the event reveals an even greater truth as Jesus tells his disciples, “I am the Bread of Life. Those who come to me will never go hungry.” The musical remains true to the Biblical accounts while underlining the theme that the most humble among us – especially children – can do great things with God’s help.

Music Camp is a week of fun for children who want to be involved in making music with other children. Our days are filled with singing games, playing instruments such as xylophones, drums and handbells and learning quality vocal literature for children. We add to this the element of drama and art work to produce a final performance for family and friends.

Who is eligible to attend?

Music camp is for excellent kids who have **completed 2nd-5th grade by the end of the 2010 school year. To plan developmentally appropriate activities, we ask that children be between the ages of 8-11. (We accept children from our Highland Church family who have completed 1st grade.)**

What are the 2010 dates?

The fun begins Monday, **June 7**, and goes through 12:00 noon on Friday, **June 11**. Our final performance will be **Thursday, June 10, at 5:30 p.m.** We strive to give each child opportunities for performance roles in the final production. Daily attendance is important so each child can be fully prepared for the final performance and gain the most from the camp experience.

Where is Music Camp?

Every morning we will begin in Fellowship Hall at Highland Baptist at 9:00 with singing and movement activities. Children move throughout the day in groups to classes in choral singing, drama and art. Afternoons (M, T, & W) will be filled with fun off-campus activities for recreation and community service. **Dismissal is at 4:30 p.m. Mon.-Wed., with a noon dismissal on Friday. (Thursday afternoon is our performance - activities are planned for the children until the 5:30 performance.**

What about food?

Each child is asked to bring their own lunch with a drink each day. Morning snacks will be provided for you at the church. Please inform the church of any allergies your child may have.

How much does Music Camp cost?

\$80.00 per child. Registration closes **Sunday, May 16**. This charge covers all supplies, materials, recreational outings, snacks & a T-shirt. Families with multiple children attending receive a 10% discount after the first registration at full price.

What do I wear and bring?

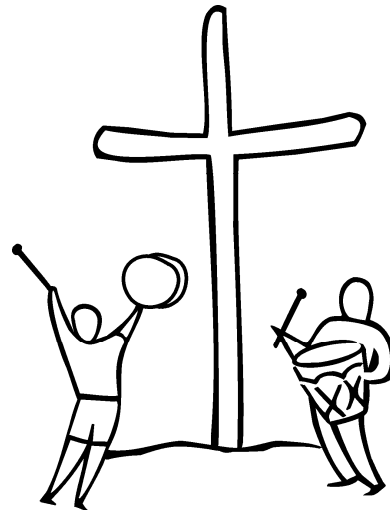
